METRO-NORTH fare options

The following rules/regulations apply for customers traveling to/from Metro-North stations ONLY.

Buy Before You Ride Traveling to and from Metro-North stations, you will pay an extra \$5 on-board trains if a ticket office is open or a TVM is available.

Peak Hours Metro-North riders are subject to AM peak-hour restrictions only; PM travel restrictions are not applicable for Metro-North riders.

Off-Peak Roundtrip Tickets (ORT) One-way travel in the direction indicated on the ticket. Not valid on weekday peak-period trains, as indicated on timetable panels. Available only for travel between certain stations. Check Ticket Vending Machine for availability.

Changing Your Terminal A flat fee of \$3.00 will be charged on-board trains when you present a ticket/pass printed with Hoboken Terminal for travel to/from New York.

Family Fares Valid after 7pm Fridays and all day Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays. Up to two children 5-11 travel free with a parent or guardian.

Children's Fares Children under 5 travel free with a parent or guardian. Children 5-11 travel for 1/2 fare.

Senior Citizens (65 and over) and Passengers with Disabilities Special fares are valid at all times but you need identification: a Medicare Card, driver's license, MTA or NJT-reduced fare card, reduced fare MetroCard, birth certificate, special MTA ID card, or Access-a-Ride Card. To receive an application for the MTA Reduced Fare Card, call 718-243-4999 or 718-596-8273 (TTY, for deaf or hard-of-hearing customers only).

Metro-North service includes all New York State stations except Suffern.

Combo Pass Metro-North customers who also use subways and buses save big on a monthly combination Metro-North/MetroCard when you purchase it by mail though Metro-North's Mail and Ride Program. For detailed information, call 212-532-4900.

Travel Flexibility Monthly and weekly commutation tickets valid between Hoboken or Penn Station-NY and Metro-North stations on the Port Jervis and Pascack Valley Lines will be honored on Metro-North's Hudson Line between Grand Central Terminal and Hudson Line stations, when the value of the Port Jervis Line or Pascack Valley Line ticket is equal to or greater than the value of the Hudson Line commutation ticket. Refunds Metro-North Station riders must submit refund requests for all tickets to NJ TRANSIT Rail Refund Dept. at One Penn Plaza East, Newark, NJ 07105-2246.

Event Service

BETMG Meadowlands Rail Line

Rail service normally operates for major events at MetLife Stadium, including Jets and Giants home games. Smaller stadium events are normally served by shuttle buses to/from Secaucus Junction. For updated service information, visit njtransit.com/meadowlands.

Connections

Hudson-Bergen Light Rail

NJ TRANSIT riders can connect to the Hudson-Bergen Light Rail at Hoboken for trips to Bayonne, Jersey City, North Bergen, Union City and Weehawken.

Secaucus Junction

Secaucus Junction connects 11 of NJ TRANSIT's 12 commuter rail lines. On the upper level you'll find the Northeast Corridor, North Jersey Coast Line and MidTOWN DIRECT service (on the Morris & Essex and Montclair-Boonton lines) to and from New York. On the lower level are the Main, Bergen County, Port Jervis and Pascack Valley lines.

Extra Service

Train 2101 operates on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, days before holidays, and holidays.

Metro-North Express Trains 1606, 1629, 2106, 2110, 2117 and 2125 are operated on behalf of MTA Metro-North Railroad.

Connecting service differs on getaway days On May 26, June 30, September 1, November 22 and December 22, Train 1629's connection departs New York at 5:20 PM and arrives in Secaucus at 5:30 PM.

Change Trains at Grove Street PATH times with a bullet require you to change at Grove Street for travel to/from the World Trade Center.

Q Indicates this train is part of the Quiet Commute program.

Customers are asked to silence all audio devices, refrain from cell phone use, conduct conversations in subdued voices, and maintain low headphone volumes to avoid disturbing other passengers. Quiet cars are available:
- On the first and last open cars of trains operating to/from New York.
- On the first car of trains operating to Hoboken.
- On the last car of trains operating from Hoboken.

Indicates that up to 12 bicycles/segways are permitted on this weekend train to/from Hoboken/Newark. Note that bicycles/segways may not be permitted on connecting NJ TRANSIT trains to/from New York at certain times. See bicycle/segway policy text in this timetable for rules and detailed information.
